## Notice of Race

The event will be hosted by Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club (CBYC). Club and Event information are available at [www.cbyc.org](http://www.cbyc.org).

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
- 1.2 Individual Classes will be governed as defined below. In the event of a conflict, individual Class Rules shall apply.

#### Farr 40 Class

- [Farr 40 Class Rules](#) as amended by the [Farr 40 West Coast Fleet Rules](#) (crew weight limit 1775 lbs)

- 1.3 The Organizing Authority (OA) is CBYC.
- 1.4 In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race (NOR) and the Sailing Instructions (SI), the SI shall prevail. **This changes RRS 63.7.**
- 1.5 Individual classes shall be responsible for administering any procedures or documents required by Class Rules.
- 1.6 **US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4 are NOT in effect.**
- 1.7 OA reserves the right to amend this NOR and to post updated NOR at [www.cbyc.org](http://www.cbyc.org).

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Entry in this regatta is open to all boats that are in compliance and good standing with the West Coast Farr 40 Fleet
- 2.2 Each boat must be entered by an individual who is a member of a yacht club or sailing association that is a Member of US Sailing (or National Authority).
- 2.3 Entries can be submitted to the CBYC office by phone, (310-519-1694) or Email, ([office@cbyc.org](mailto:office@cbyc.org)) CBYC entry forms are available on line at [www.cbyc.org](http://www.cbyc.org) or in the CBYC office. Entries will close at 10AM Saturday August 19.

**3. FEES**

The entry fee is \$100.00 USD for the Farr 40 Class.

**4. SCHEDULE**

**Saturday, August 19**

1000hrs: Skipper's Meeting in the members lounge  
1300hrs: Warning Signal Race 1  
ASAP Warning Signal Races 2 & 3

**Sunday, August 20**

1300hrs: Warning Signal Race 4  
ASAP Warning Signal Race 5  
1700hrs: Post Race Reception and awards at CBYC.

**No Race Shall Be Started after 1530 Hours on August 20th**

The Race Committee (RC) at its discretion may run fewer races on Saturday or more races on Sunday or less than the five (5) scheduled races based on wind and weather conditions.

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions (SI) will be available at CBYC and at [www.cbyc.org](http://www.cbyc.org).

**6. RACING AREA**

The racing area will be behind the Middle breakwater or in the Pacific Ocean, approximately (3/4) mile at 220 degrees from Angels Gate.

**7. COURSES**

Courses shall be windward/leeward with windward offset and leeward gates per the SI

**8. SCORING**

8.1 The Low Point System of RRS Appendix A will apply except that all scores will count. **This changes Rule A2.**

8.2 Five (5) races are scheduled. Two (2) races must be completed to constitute a regatta

**9. RADIO COMMUNICATION**

The RC shall communicate information on channel 72 and make every effort to broadcast course and OCS information to boats on the water.

**10. PRIZES**

Trophies will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place boats.

**11. SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats shall be permitted, subject to any provisions of individual Class Rules.
